Treatment keeps folks healthy & untransmittable.



Starting treatment immediately is important.



There is no cure, but treatment can make viral loads undetectable.



Staying undetectable can make a person live a long, healthy life.



When undetectable, a person can't transmit HIV to a sexual partner.



It can take up to 6 months to become undetectable.

What is U=U?

Undetectable = Untransmittable

U=U means that people living with HIV who have an undetectable level of virus in their blood due to treatment are unable to transmit the virus to others.

ZERO Transmissions!

There have been ZERO reported cases of HIV from people who have sex with someone who is undetectable making it the most effective way to stop HIV.



Paying

Insurance plans must cover some HIV treatment costs. Medicare, Medicaid and Ryan White can help uninsured individuals.

The Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program, first enacted in 1990, is the nation's safety net program for people with HIV serving over half of all those diagnosed.
